We met with the employer today and continued negotiations on a new Collective Agreement. We'd like to share a quick update with all of you.

We had another productive day and will meet with the employer again next Monday, on June 14th.

As we have shared in previous updates, the two other CUPE locals in Vancouver (CUPE 15 and CUPE 1004) have already ratified agreements with the city. As we move closer to our own agreement, we feel that these recent agreements may provide useful context.
